1. Executive reviewed the scheduled meeting dates for the upcoming year. A decision was made to defer the Executive Planning Retreat, originally scheduled for May 1, to the fall.
2. Alan Campbell was formally appointed to the MASS/MSBA COVID-19; Education Stakeholders COVID-19; CSBA/CASSA national coordination; and Manitoba Education Response Planning Team / Liaison committees.
3. Alan Campbell sought Executive feedback on the first weekly board chairs video-conference on COVID-19, which was held on March 31. Executive members provided input on the most effective and efficient use of time for future meetings, which will occur weekly.
