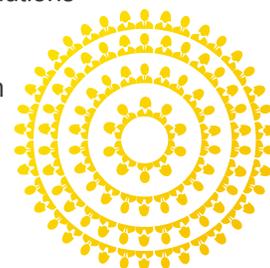

REGIONAL MEETINGS

A necessary precursor to convention are regional meetings, which take place next month. For those new to the association, regional meetings bring together trustees from proximate divisions for an opportunity to hear about their organization's ongoing work and priorities. These meetings also provide a chance for boards to seek regional support for proposed convention resolutions, and to discuss matters of local concern or interest.

In early January, a regional meeting package will be distributed to all school boards. This package will include a summary of the association's budget and financial position, reports from key committees, and resolutions proposed by both boards and the provincial executive. The deadline for receipt of resolutions at the association office is Friday, December 12; they should be directed to Executive Assistant [Andrea Kehler](#).



Of particular note this year will be two by-law amendments being put forward by your provincial executive. One of these deals with a proposed change to the method whereby member fees are calculated, and the other proposes some changes to executive election processes, specifically nomination deadlines and voting methods. All votes relating to by-laws are determined by weighted, board ballots, with the weighting dependent upon the student population of a division, so you'll want to make sure you discuss these important changes at your own board table prior to convention.
