2024 Manitoba Students Leading Change Scholarship/Bursary

Your Future, Your Community

As students across Canada continue to invest in their education, many are taking the time to invest in their communities as well. In recognition of the growing number of Canadian students showing a passion to lead and inspire positive change in their community, we have created the TADD Manitoba Scholarship/Bursary.

The Scholarships

We are offering four students Leading Change Scholarship/Bursary's worth \$500.00 each (two scholarships, two bursaries). The scholarship/bursary is open to all students within Manitoba. However, preference will be given to those students who are actively involved in their TADD school groups/committees.

Who can Apply?

1. Graduating Manitoba high school students currently enrolled in their final year and who will be enrolled full-time in a degree or diploma program at a recognized publicly funded Canadian university or college in the Fall 2024 academic term.

Applicants for the scholarship must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents with a ***minimum 70% average in their last completed year of study.***

2. Graduating Manitoba high school students actively involved in their community and inspiring change at the local level.

Applicants for the bursary must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents and have engaged in actions, raised awareness for a cause directed either to their school community, their local community or their provincial community. A letter of reference from a member of the community who can attest to the leadership and advocacy that has been demonstrated by the student.

Where can I apply?

What is the Deadline?

Applications will be accepted until **Friday, May 24, 2024 at 3:00 p.m.**

When are the winners announced?

Winners will be announced on or before June 14, 2024. The successful winners must claim their scholarship funds by **no later than September 2024.**
